

NEW ZEALAND GREYHOUND CUP NOTICE

Due to Covid restrictions this year's event is unfortunately not open to the public and will be restricted to 100 Sponsors and Invited Guests in each of the Blossom Lady and Terror to Love Lounges. Each of the two rooms in use will have separate entrance and access routes. Guests will be required to remain in their respective lounge during the race meeting and will be unable to move between lounges or to handle or visit the Trainers and Handlers area. Unfortunately there will be no complimentary Dining for the connections of this year's Group 1 finalists. All Group 1 Finalists will receive a personalised framed photograph of their greyhound to commemorate their achievement.

Trainers and Handlers will park in the normal Orangetheory Rugby Park area and have access to catering facilities in the stables Pop Up area.

Handlers should note that ties must be worn for all races on Cup Night with Bow Ties provided by the Club for the Handlers of the 3 Group 1 Races.

The Box Draw for the 3 Group 1 races is unable to be live after the Semi Finals this year and will be conducted by GRNZ at 10am Thursday 4 November.

Sponsors and Invited attendees to the meeting will enter the course through a gate at the Harness Float park entrance where an attendant will check their name is on the attendance register and be issued a wristband appropriate to the Lounge they will be Dining in for the evening.

Diners will not be able move between the rooms and Level 3 is the only 2 rooms in the main Stand that will be open. Spectators will be closed.
